The ***Financial Statistics Report, FY2006*** displays income and expenditure data submitted by 362 (98%) of the Commonwealth's 370 independent public libraries.

Data in this report is displayed in two separate tables; Total Income and Expenditures and Per Capita Figures. Definitions for all of the data items presented are provided at the end of the report.

This report provides information that may be used to describe library services, support long-range and budget planning, strengthen service evaluation and advance informed decision-making. Users will want to interpret this data in the context of the service roles adopted by each library and expressed in its mission statement.

Their work contributes to planning library services and development at the state and national levels as well as the local level, and is greatly appreciated.
