The ***Circulation and Holdings Report, FY2009*** displays data submitted by 365 (99%) of the Commonwealth's 370 independent public libraries in eight population groupings. The library data includes main, branch and bookmobile data.

Users will want to interpret this data in the context of the service roles adopted by the library and expressed in its mission statement.
